What the course covers



Cruise ship security is handled by a team of professionals with differing levels of responsibility. Security guards at the lower levels have duties such as screening passengers, making rounds, and reporting unusual or suspicious activity. Those at the higher levels put together security plans and determine how to respond to incidents of varying levels of seriousness.

This course will provide you with the skills to address the day to day functions and duties of a Ship Security Officer as well as understanding and following the ship's procedures to carry out your designated duties.
